



Jesus said to his disciples:

"You have heard that it was said,

But I say to you, offer no resistance to one who is evil. When someone strikes you on your right cheek, turn the other one as well.

If anyone wants your tunic, hand over your cloak as well.

Should anyone make you walk one mile with them, offer to go for two miles.

Give to the one who asks of you, and don't refuse anyone who wants to borrow from you.

"You have heard that it was said,
You shall love your neighbour and hate your enemy.

But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who make life difficult for you, that you may be children of your heavenly Father, for he makes his sun rise on bad as well as good people, and causes the rain to fall on the just and the unjust.

For if you love those who love you, what advantage is that to you with God? Don't bad people do the same to those they love?

And if you only greet your family and friends, what is unusual about that?

Don't those who do not believe in God do the same?

So be perfect, just as your heavenly Father is perfect."




