## Seapatrick Parish Draw Terms and Conditions

- 1. All donations are voluntary.
- 2. To be eligible for entry to the draw, you may pay £60 for the year either by Standing Order, Cheque or Cash or alternatively you may pay £5 per month either by Standing Order or Cash. If paying monthly, draw entry money must be received *no later than the last Wednesday of each month*.

A receipt will be issued for all cash/cheque payments received in the Parish Office.

Any monthly payment received after the deadline will result in the number not being included in the draw for that month.

- 3. A draw of £100 will normally be drawn weekly starting the first Thursday in September and an additional draw of £500 will be drawn monthly on the last Thursday of each month. The first draw on the last Thursday of the month will be for £100. That winning number will go back into the drum and then the second draw for £500 will be drawn.
- 4. Currently the draw is made each Thursday night at the Bingo in Seapatrick Parish Centre, Edenderry Road, Banbridge. On a Thursday night when there is no Bingo (eg Christmas Eve/Day, New Year's Eve/Day, Holy Thursday & Parish Cemetery Mass night) the draw will be made on the previous Thursday night at the Bingo. Should the Bingo have to be cancelled at short notice (eg due to inclement weather) then that draw will be made on the following Thursday night at the Bingo.
- 5. The winner will be chosen at random from all valid entries. Should a number be drawn and is found to be an invalid entry then that week's/month's draw will be redrawn on the following Thursday night at the Bingo.
- 6. Winner's name, address and draw number will be published in Seapatrick Parish Bulletin and displayed on the window of the Parish Centre. A cheque will be delivered/posted to the winner.

It is your responsibility to ensure the Parish Office has accurate, up to date contact details for you.

7. Seapatrick Parish Finance Committee reserves the right at any time and from time to time to modify these Terms and Conditions. The decision of the Parish Finance Committee is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
